

SHEDARESTHEDEVIL SHIPS WEST TO WIN CLEMENT HIRSCH

Shedaresthedevil, favored at odds of 6-5, turned in a perfect dress rehearsal for the Longines Breeders' Cup Distaff (G1) in the \$300,000 Clement L. Hirsch Stakes (G1) Aug. 1. Trainer Brad Cox had shipped the 2020 Longines Kentucky Oaks (G1) winner to Del Mar for the Clement Hirsch to give the filly a prep over the track where this year's Breeders' Cup will be held.

As an added benefit, the race gave Shedaresthedevil a "Win & You're In" berth to the Nov. 6 Distaff.

Three-time graded winner Venetian Harbor, the 2-1 third choice, sped to the lead when the gates opened. Second-choice As Time Goes By, on the rail after the scratches of Warren's Showtime and Clockstrikestwelve, bobbed slightly, which put her last early.

Ridden by Florent Geroux, Shedaresthedevil came out well from the outside post in the five-horse field and quickly angled into a good position in third, just outside and on the hip of Venetian Harbor. Longshot Paige Anne raced in second along the rail.

Venetian Harbor clocked the first quarter-mile in :23.30 and a half-mile in :47.21. Before the field reached the second turn, she started to edge away. Shedaresthedevil closed the gap almost immediately, however, ranging up to head Venetian Harbor just before the quarter pole.

Venetian Harbor succeeded in staying with Shedaresthedevil for

several strides into the stretch, but ultimately Shedaresthedevil had too much in reserve. Shedaresthedevil easily pulled away to win by 3 1/4 lengths, completing 1 1/16 miles on the fast track in 1:45.38. Venetian Harbor finished second, another 3 1/4 lengths in front of Paige Anne.

"The idea was to get her to break alertly, then get a good spot," Geroux said. "That's exactly what happened. She ran her race today, and she's very good when she does."

Shedaresthedevil paid \$4.60, \$2.60, and \$2.60. Venetian Harbor returned \$3.20 and \$3.60, and Paige Anne paid \$5.80.

Eric Gary, an assistant to Cox, saddled Shedaresthedevil for the ownership group of Flurry Racing Stables, Qatar Racing, and Big Aut Farms.

"We sat right off the lead, nice, calm, and relaxed, and when it was time to go, she showed up like she was supposed to," said Gary. "Being around her this morning, I

had a really good feeling that she was going to run big today."

A 4-year-old Kentucky-bred daughter of Daredevil—Starship Warpspeed, by Congrats, Shedaresthedevil won her third grade 1, following last year's Kentucky Oaks and the April 30 La Troienne Stakes Presented by Twinspires.com (G1). Both of those races were at her home base of Churchill Downs. In her most recent effort, Shedaresthedevil ran third in the June 5 Ogden Phipps Stakes (G1) at Belmont Park, behind winner Letruska.

Though the Hirsch gave Cox, the Eclipse Award-winning trainer of 2020, an indication of how Shedaresthedevil might do in the Breeders' Cup, the filly had raced at Del Mar before. In the care of trainer Simon Callaghan at 2 in 2019, she ran third in the Sorrento Stakes (G2) at the Southern California track.

WinStar Farm bred Shedaresthedevil, who has gone through the sales ring three times. Flurry Racing Stables purchased her for \$280,000 from consignor Hunter Valley Farm at the 2019 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. The filly is from the first crop of Daredevil, and she is a half sister to Mojovation, who finished third in the 2017 Futurity Stakes (G3) at Belmont. Her dam, Starship Warpspeed, has a yearling filly by Exaggerator, produced a colt by Uncle Mo in March, and was bred back to Uncle Mo for 2022.

Starship Warpspeed is also dam of the unraced 2-year-old Speightster filly Blackheartedgypsy, a \$350,000 purchase by Flurry Racing Stables from the Woodford Thoroughbreds consignment to the 2020 Keeneland September Yearling Sale. Blackheartedgypsy recorded four works between late June and mid-July at Keeneland.

Gary said that Shedaresthedevil, an earner of \$2,047,318 from an 8-2-4 record in 15 starts, is

JACKIE'S WARRIOR SPLASHES TO VICTORY IN AMSTERDAM

Apparently neither lightning nor an infamous Saratoga downpour can slow trainer Steve Asmussen's pursuit of the sport's all-time wins record or the ascent of Jackie's Warrior into a force for the Breeders' Cup.

After lightning and rain delayed the start of the Aug. 1 Amsterdam Stakes (G2) for 3-year-olds by about 30 minutes, J. Kirk and Judy Robison's Jackie's Warrior handled the soaked track at Saratoga Race Course like a speed boat, gliding to an easy, 7 1/4-length victory in the \$200,000, 6 1/2-furlong stakes.

"I wouldn't be scared of running him against anyone at one turn," Asmussen said about the son of Maclean's Music. "And how do I measure that? We've had some good ones and he's one of them."


Asmussen, a Hall of Fame trainer since 2016, has had plenty of "good ones" in his career, explaining why Jackie's Warrior was the 9,442nd victory of his career, putting him just three shy of Dale Baird's all-time record of 9,445.

"Any day you have Jackie's Warrior win the Amsterdam like that you feel pretty good as a trainer, but we are three wins away (from the record) and we'll have to pick up our slack at Louisiana Downs the next few days," Asmussen said.

Asmussen has one horse entered Aug. 2 at each of three tracks (Louisiana Downs, Colonial Downs, and Indiana Grand Race Course), and four at Louisiana Downs and one at Indiana Grand the following day.

Jackie's Warrior has accounted for six of those 9,442 wins and tacked on the latest one as he returned to the track that skyrocketed him to prominence while atoning for a race that could have added another win to Asmussen's glittering total.

Winner of the Saratoga Special Stakes Presented by Miller Lite (G2) and Runhappy Hopeful Stakes (G1) at the Spa in 2020, Jackie's Warrior came into the Amsterdam after a runner-up finish behind Drain the Clock at even-money odds in the June 5 Woody Stephens Stakes Presented by Nassau County Industrial Development Agency (G1) at Belmont Park over a good track. Jackie's Warrior broke slowly and was steadied by jockey Joel Rosario that day, then rushed out to grab a short lead over Drain the Clock in the seven-furlong Stephens. Fatigue caught up with Jackie's Warrior in the final furlong as Drain the Clock prevailed by a neck.

In Sunday's rematch of the two Maclean's Music 3-year-olds, it was no contest once the weather cleared.

"They are great here in informing you with where you're at and what you're doing," Asmussen said. "(State steward Braulio Baeza Jr.) and everybody else covered what they were looking at as far as the lightning and the delay. I don't care if it's an hour or a week, we'll show up."

This time, Jackie's Warrior broke smoothly for Rosario and dueled for the lead with the Saffie Joseph Jr.-trained Drain the Clock through a quarter-mile in :21.46.

"We got caught being overconfident last time," Asmussen said. "(Rosario) helped him away from there today and held him together and the horse ran extremely well."

The 1-2 favorite pulled away on the turn through a half-mile in a blazing :43.85 and never looked back.

"He's fast and then he just keeps going," Rosario said.

Ahead by five lengths in mid-stretch, he crossed the wire in 1:15.46 over a sloppy, sealed surface to post his first victory on a wet track. Besides the Stephens, he was third in the Southwest Stakes (G3) on a sloppy surface in February.

"He's a very special horse and he's showed that on many occasions. He gets the respect that I think he deserves and it's extremely fun to watch him run," Asmussen said. "He will have a lot to say in the one-turn division."

Bred in Kentucky by J & J Stables out of the A. P. Five Hundred mare Unicorn Girl, Jackie's Warrior is his dam's third foal and first stakes winner. He was purchased for \$95,000 at the Keeneland September Yearling Sale as part of the Taylor Made Sales Agency consignment.

Unicorn Girl also has a 2-year-old Candy Ride filly named Lenni Girl who has yet to race and a yearling American Pharoah colt.

Grade 1-winning Drain the Clock, owned by Slam Dunk Racing, Madaket Stables, Wonder Stables, and Michael Nentwig, ran on for second by a length over Klaravich Stables' Crowded Trade in the field of six.

A son of More Than Ready trained by Chad Brown, Crowded Trade made his first start since finishing fifth in the May 15 Preakness Stakes (G1).

Asmussen said the Aug. 28 H. Allen Jerkens Memorial Stakes (G1) at seven furlongs would be next for Jackie's Warrior. The \$500,000 stakes for 3-year-olds is contested at Saratoga where the bay colt is now 3-for-3.

"Jackie's Warrior's résumé here at Saratoga is hard to match," Asmussen said. "This race was to get back on track for the Jerkens." BH

ESSENTIAL QUALITY REMAINS ON COURSE FOR TRAVERS

Essential Quality was a determined victor of July 31 Jim Dandy Stakes (G2) at Saratoga Race Course and will now target the meet's signature event, the \$1.25 million Runhappy Travers Stakes (G1) Aug. 28.

Godolphin's homebred son of Tapit, trained by Brad Cox, overcame a five-wide trip on both turns, rated at the rear of the compact field down the backstretch, and fended off an inside rally from Keepmeinmind to finish off the nine furlongs in 1:49.92 over the fast main track.

"The more I looked at it, the more I wondered how much pace was in the race and then I thought we'd be forwardly placed just because he was fresh," Cox said. "The horse to the inside of us (Keepmeinmind) was also fresh. I think it played out kind of the way we expected, obviously I didn't think we would be caught quite as wide, but I thought it would be a well-grouped bunch of horses going into the first turn. He's able to dig in and fight and continue on."

Essential Quality, last year's champion 2-year-old male, will look to become the first horse since Alpha in 2012 to capture the Jim Dandy-Travers double.

Cox could hold a strong hand for the Travers as Juddmonte's Mandaloun, winner of the TVG.com Haskell Stakes (G1) upon the disqualification of Hot Rod Charlie, is also a possible contender. Cox said a breeze next weekend will likely determine which direction Mandaloun goes.

Lexitonian Possible for Forego

After taking Saturday's Alfred G. Vanderbilt Handicap (G1) at odds of 34-1, Calumet Farm's homebred Lexitonian could make a return engagement at Saratoga in the \$600,000 Forego Stakes (G1) at seven furlongs Aug. 28.

"Right after the race, I like to set a plan and obviously we're here in Saratoga and he handled the track well yesterday, so the next stop could potentially be the Forego," trainer Jack Sisterson said. "We'll see how he comes out of the race and goes from there. But you're looking at the race at Belmont (the grade 2 Vosburgh Stakes Oct. 9) or bringing back home for the Phoenix (G2, Oct. 8 at Keeneland). The ultimate goal is the Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1) at the end of the year."

Whitmore, last year's champion male sprinter who ran third in the Vanderbilt, is also under consideration for the Forego, trainer Ron Moquett confirmed.

"We're looking at the Forego," Moquett said. "I was very proud of how he came back out of the race. Obviously, we'll pay attention to him

the next week or so and see if he's up for it, but that's what we're hoping for."

Moquett explained taking dirt down the backstretch didn't do Whitmore any favors in the Vanderbilt.

"I'm sure it didn't help. He's sensitive about his eyes so that may have been why he decided to run outside instead of through the rail, but it looked like a lot of horses were taking kick back," Moquett said. BH

MCPEEK SEEKS HEARING OVER DENIAL OF ENTRIES

Though the Equine Herpesvirus-1 quarantine on horses stabled at Barn 86 at Saratoga Race Course was lifted Aug. 1, the ill feelings from the parameters of sidelining those horses have not.

Attorney Andrew Mollica filed a demand Sunday on behalf of trainer Ken McPeek for a hearing with the New York State Gaming Commission over its ruling to deny the taking of entries on any of the horses involved in the quarantine until Sunday, preventing those horses from racing the until the Aug. 6 card, which is drawn Sunday.

McPeek, who has 30 horses at Barn 86 that were placed under a 21-day quarantine retroactive to July 11, tried to enter one horse for Sunday's card on July 29, three on July 30 for the Aug. 4 card, and three on July 31 for the Aug. 5 program, but those entries were denied by state's Gaming Commission steward Braulio Baeza Jr., who cited that entries for those horses could not be accepted until Sunday.

McPeek and Mollica contend it was not made clear that entries could not be accepted until Sunday and that it is "illogical" and "nonsensical" to deny horses the right to race on the same day they were cleared to rejoin the equine community and resume working out at the main track and Oklahoma Training Track as normal.

"I am doing this so that the next time this happens, trainers and owners will not have to go through another situation like this where there are an extra three to five days when their horses cannot run because there is no clarity in New York. I don't want to see anyone else go through this," McPeek said. "Officials need to address some standard operating procedures and protocols for everyone that make sense. To keep horses who have cleared quarantine from not running is nonsensical."

In his request for a hearing, Mollica wrote that he was "demanding a hearing for clarity and any just relief deemed proper by the New York State Gaming Commission for the irrevocable harm caused by the arbitrary and capricious denial of the ability to enter eligible horses trained by McPeek in races at Saratoga Racecourse subsequent to August 1, 2021, in violation of the Commission's publicly announced policy to permit such participation."

He added in the letter, "Mr. McPeek, (and his owners) were put on Public Notice by the Commission that the horses effected by the quarantine would be released from quarantine and permitted to both rejoin the general horse population (and race) on August 1, 2021. (See numerous press releases and news stories giving notice attached hereto as Exhibit A). Mr. McPeek (and his owners) detrimentally relied upon this publicly disseminated official policy to prepare his horses to rejoin the general horse population and in turn race at Saratoga Racecourse commencing August 1, 2021."

Mollica said he reached out to Baeza July 30 in hopes of the entries being accepted in advance of an immediate hearing to determine whether they could run, but did not receive a response.



"Our position is very clear. We were told we were clear Aug. 1. If you wouldn't let us run on that day, wouldn't you say that? No one said anything to us about that. We followed their protocols. Kenny detrimentally relied on the commitment they made to him and his owners," Mollica said. "He entered Thursday because he was told he was clear Aug. 1. Not only is this arbitrary and capricious, the game is hard enough without the Commission working against people. It's illogical."

Baeza would not comment on the matter due to legal concerns.

McPeek said the situation should have been handled better by Baeza and the Racing Commission.

"There are certain officials that could have done a better job handling this. We were supposed to start back Aug. 1, then we were able to run Aug. 1, then the state steward decided that we couldn't, which we have never been given an explanation for, which, to me, is unacceptable. That's been disconcerting," McPeek said. "Martin Panza (the New York Racing Association's senior vice

president of racing operations) has done a fantastic job of keeping me informed, doing everything he could, and fighting for what we need. I'm very disappointed in the state steward (Baeza). I think he's done us an injustice. We should have been able to run (Sunday) and to add three more race days to this is wrong. It's one of the worst decisions I've ever seen by a racing official. I don't get it.

"What's the logic here?" he added. "It's been easier for (trainers) Marcus Vitali and Bob Baffert to run at Saratoga than me."

The horses McPeek tried in vain to enter are grade 1 winner Simply Ravishing, Fighting Seabee, Laynlomakndough, Penny Saver, Knightly Mischief, Wicked Bobby, and Far Away Look.

Among the McPeek horses who exited quarantine Sunday and worked out were Preakness Stakes (G1) winner Swiss Skydiver (five furlongs in 1:01.21 on the main track), grade 3 winner King Fury (five furlongs in 1:01.25 on the Oklahoma turf course), who worked in company with Fighting Seabee, and 2-year-old

filly Penny Saver. Swiss Skydiver is headed to the Aug. 7 Whitney Stakes (G1) while King Fury is expected to run in a grass race Saturday as a prep for the Aug. 28 Runhappy Travers Stakes (G1). BH

SWISS SKYDIVER TURNS IN FINAL WORK FOR WHITNEY

Peter Callahan's three-time grade 1 winner Swiss Skydiver put in her final serious preparation Aug. 1 ahead of the Aug. 7, \$1 million Whitney Stakes (G1) at Saratoga Race Course.

With Irad Ortiz Jr. aboard, the 4-year-old daughter of Daredevil went five furlongs in 1:01.21 over the fast Saratoga main track.

A winner over six different ovals, including Saratoga when she captured last year's Alabama Stakes (G1), Swiss Skydiver has won with five different jockeys aboard.

Ortiz Jr. will look to increase that number when he pilots the chestnut filly in the Whitney.

"He loved her and said she felt great," trainer Kenny McPeek said. "We're excited, we should be ready. She's adaptable to racetracks and jockeys, it doesn't really matter."

Swiss Skydiver has posted six graded stakes wins over five different ovals with her biggest claim to fame taking place against males in last year's Preakness Stakes (G1). The last female to capture the Whitney was undefeated Hall of Famer Personal Ensign in 1988.

The Whitney is part of the Breeders' Cup Challenge Series and awards the winner a berth in the Nov. 6 Longines Breeders' Cup Classic (G1) at Del Mar.

McPeek breezed graded stakes winner King Fury over the Oklahoma Training Track turf Sunday in preparation for Saturday's \$1 million Saratoga Derby Invitational (G1T) at 1 3/16 miles over the Mellon turf course.

The son of Curlin, out of grade 1 winner Taris, worked with Jose Ortiz aboard in

company with Fighting Seabee, winner of the 2019 With Anticipation Stakes (G3T), and finished off his five-furlong move in 1:01.25.

Owned by Fern Circle Stables and Three Chimneys Farm, King Fury scored in the April 10 Stonestreet Lexington Stakes (G3) over a sloppy and sealed track at Keeneland two starts back. He arrives at his turf debut off a close second to Masqueparade in the June 26 Ohio Derby (G3) at Thistledown.

McPeek said he would like to run King Fury in the Aug. 28, \$1.25 million Runhappy Travers (G1) at the Spa.

"Jose seemed to think that he can handle the turf," McPeek said. "We'll learn a little something about him, and it's a big purse. That's been our goal all summer is to get him to the Travers. The turf race is looking deep but it shouldn't hurt him."

"It's a very good group of 3-year-olds and Essential Quality had another workmanlike win yesterday (in Saratoga's Jim Dandy Stakes, G2), but it's hard to separate the 3-year-olds until the Breeders' Cup," McPeek continued. "That's the race that really separates everybody." BH

MONOMOY GIRL BACK UNDER TACK BUT BREEDERS' CUP UNLIKELY

The two-time champion mare Monomoy Girl is once again under tack and walking at WinStar Farm and is expected to be back in trainer Brad Cox's barn in about three weeks, but appears unlikely to be ready for the Breeders' Cup in early November.

"She looks amazing," Cox said about the mare owned by Spendthrift Farm, MyRacehorse Stable, and Madaket Stables. "We're optimistic that if all goes well we should have her back in the barn in about three weeks and take her to Ellis Park and then Churchill Downs."

Given that timing, Cox said targets later in the year or next year, such as the Clark Stakes Presented by Norton Healthcare (G1), Cigar Mile (G1), or Pegasus World Cup Invitational Stakes (G1), are more conceivable targets for her as opposed to the Nov. 6 Longines Breeders' Cup Distaff (G1), a race she has already captured twice in 2018 and 2020.

"We'll talk it over with (Spendthrift's) Ned Toffey (general manager) and Eric Gustavson (owner) and everyone else to come up with a game plan. The Breeders' Cup would be really tight and I don't know if it's a possibility, but there are some other races out there for her. There's no pressure. She's such an accomplished mare and has done so much, she will only run if she's 100% right."

Monomoy Girl, a 6-year-old daughter of Tapizar, was turned out due to minor muscle strains and hamstring soreness after finishing second to Letruska in the April 17 Apple Blossom Handicap (G1) at Oaklawn Park.

The champion 3-year-old filly in 2018 and last year's champion older dirt female, Monomoy Girl has won 14 of 17 starts with earnings of \$4,776,818.

She was originally owned by Sol Kumin's Monomoy Stables, Michael Dubb, The Elkstone Group, and Bethlehem Stables and was sold to Spendthrift for \$9.5 million from the ELITE consignment at The November Sale, Fasig-Tipton's selected breeding stock sale in Kentucky, last fall. Spendthrift then leased shares of her racing rights to MyRacehorse and Kumin's Madaket Stables. **BH**

PRAT RECEIVES SEVEN-DAY SUSPENSION FOR HASKELL DQ

Jockey Flavien Prat received a seven-day suspension from the stewards Aug. 1 at Monmouth Park as a result of his ride aboard Hot Rod Charlie in the TVG.com Haskell Stakes (G1).

The California-based rider's suspension begins Sept. 7 and ends Sept. 13, which is one day after Del Mar closes and prior to the Oct. 1 start of the Santa Anita Park meet.

Hot Rod Charlie was disqualified from first in the Haskell and placed last.

In their ruling, the stewards said Prat "failed to make a reasonable effort to keep his horse from drifting in past the 1/8-mile pole, allowing his horse (to) cross in front of Midnight Bourbon, which resulted in Midnight Bourbon clipping heels with Hot Rod Charlie, causing Midnight Bourbon to stumble badly, unseating his rider."

Brad Pegram, Prat's agent, said Sunday morning that he had yet to discuss with his rider whether he will file an appeal.

In the Haskell, Prat, and the other jockeys, were not allowed to use their riding crops except as a safety measure due to restrictions put in place this year by the New Jersey Horse Racing Commission. Immediately after the race, Prat told BloodHorse he believed he could have prevented Hot Rod Charlie from drifting if he was able to provide left-handed encouragement with his crop.

AMALFI COAST RALLIES TO ROYAL NORTH SCORE AT WOODBINE

Trainer Kevin Attard and jockey Justin Stein teamed up to win a pair of stakes Aug. 1 at Woodbine, including the CA\$196,000 (US\$157,057) Royal North Stakes (G2T) with Terra Racing Stable homebred Amalfi Coast.

The victory came one race after Attard gave Stein a leg up on the successful Munnyfor Ro in the Woodbine Oaks Presented by Budweiser.

Amalfi Coast rallied up the rail in the six-furlong Royal North for fillies and mares, coming out on top by a nose over Jeanie B in a photo finish. The final time on the firm turf was 1:09.15.

"She's push-button to ride; very professional horse," said Stein. "She knows what she's doing. I've watched her run and got to be fortunate enough to ride her and steer her around a few times. When I pulled the trigger, she gives me everything she's got. She came over ready and is a pleasure to be around. She's a really nice horse."

Jeanie B pressed the frontrunning Sister Peacock through fractions of :22.78 and :45.83 and seemed headed for victory after taking charge and reaching the furlong pole with a length advantage. But Amalfi Coast was closing hard along the rail and got the nod over the game runner-up with the even-money favorite Change of Control another half-length back in third. Last year's Royal North winner Lady Grace finished fourth with Fairywren, Sister Peacock, and Jeannie's Beepbeep rounding out the order of finish.

Lead Guitar broke behind the field and was deemed to have received an unfair start, with the stewards ordering a full pari-mutuel refund.

Amalfi Coast returned \$9.60 for a \$2 win ticket.

A 5-year-old daughter of Tapizar, Amalfi Coast

was bred in Ontario out of the Include mare Include Katherine. She is a half sister to graded stakes-placed Why Katherine, stakes-placed Chris' Brew, and stakes-placed Afleet Katherine.

Amalfi Coast increased her earnings to \$480,367 with a 6-2-3 record in 16 starts.

"It's a funny game," said Attard. "She's a special horse. Last year she ran into some issues--some bad luck and a little throat issue early on. I kind of mismanaged her maybe a little bit wrong, so this year we came in with a different game plan. She's really appreciated that and she's showing the horse that she's capable of being."

Souper Stonehenge Holds On in Vigil

Souper Stonehenge assumed command early and held off a closing bid by Pink Lloyd to capture the CA\$159,300 (US\$127,649) Vigil Stakes (G3) at the Ontario track, besting the seven-time Sovereign Award winner for a second straight race.

Live Oak Plantation's homebred Souper Stonehenge, trained by Mark Casse, held on to win by three-quarters of a length. He was piloted by Patrick Husbands and completed the six furlongs on the fast track in 1:09.52.

"It's good to sit on light horses and good to sit on good horses," said Husbands. "I've ridden probably 180 big races for Mark; he never gave me instructions. I have the confidence in this horse, that what it is."

"He left there—what he wanted to do—(and I) just left him alone. It worked out good today."

Souper Stonehenge led through fractions of :22.96 and :45.73. Green Light Go forced the issue through the opening quarter with Not So Quiet also in close attendance and taking over second place as the leader reached the half while maintaining a one-length advantage.

Pink Lloyd, meanwhile, had been shuffled back to last in the field of six but hit his stride after straightening out for home and was gallant in defeat while leaving Not So Quiet three-quarters of a length back in third. Cash Dividend, Embolden, and Green Light Go rounded out the order of finish.

Souper Stonehenge returned \$2.70 as the favorite while ending Pink Lloyd's bid for a fifth consecutive Vigil score. He also defeated Pink Lloyd in the June 20 Jacques Cartier Stakes (G3).

A 5-year-old gelding by Speightstown, Souper Stonehenge was bred in Florida out of the stakes-winning Medaglia d'Oro mare Onepointhreekarats. He is a half brother to grade 1-placed stakes winner Tap It to Win.

Souper Stonehenge holds a 5-4-1 record in 16 starts and has earned \$343,705.

"He's one of my little favorites," said Husbands. "We kid around, we play around. He's just a horse you want to be around." BH



MUNNYFOR RO OUTRUNS FOES IN WOODBINE OAKS

Munnyfor Ro, under a patient ride from Justin Stein, took the CA\$500,800 (US\$401,300) Woodbine Oaks Presented by Budweiser Aug. 1 at Woodbine.

Trained by Kevin Attard for Raroma Stable, Munnyfor Ro was the last to load in the first leg of the Triple Tiara for Canadian-bred 3-year-old fillies, but was first when it counted most, setting herself up for a shot at the Aug. 22 Queen's Plate.

It was Lorena, undefeated in three starts coming into the Oaks, who led the way through a quarter-mile in :24.35. Lorena was still in command while Munnyfor Ro cruised comfortably in eighth spot, and remained there after a half-mile went in :48.41.

As the field began to envelop Lorena, Munnyfor Ro, sixth after three-quarters in 1:12.35, began to pick off rivals one by one. The Munnings filly was full of run around the turn for home. At the stretch call, she was a half-length ahead of a determined Emmeline, who continued to fight on along the rail.

At the wire, Munnyfor Ro was a 1 1/4-length winner. Emmeline stayed on for second, a nose ahead of Il Malocchio. The final time for the 1 1/8 miles was 1:50.31 on the fast all-weather track. Munnyfor Ro, the 3-1 third choice, returned \$8.70 for the win.


"I was told the key with her is to have her settled," noted Stein. "The pace ... it looked like there was probably some possibility of them stopping, which we didn't want to be in behind them. I put her in a spot that we could tip out in the turn when it came time to ask her to run from the quarter pole home. We had a dream trip; worked out perfect."

It was an Oaks first for Attard and a second for Stein, who teamed with Academic to take the 2015 running.

"We were expecting a good performance out of her," said Attard. "She came up here this season in good shape from (trainer) Brian Lynch—had a great campaign over the winter time. She ran a fabulous race (second) in the Selene (G3). I thought she'd move off that race forwardly enough to kind of be really competitive here today. Had a good interim breeze and put it all together."

For owner Rajendra Maharajh, it was a perfect day from start to finish.

"My good buddy Art Fisher from Ocala picked her out for me," said Maharajh, who named the horse for his son Ro. "She came up here (last year) and ran two races. She was a little immature at the time. We sent her down to Florida and gave her the winter off and then with COVID, my other trainer, Brian Lynch, took her over and prepped her up, and we were always planning for this race. Brian did a fabulous job getting her ready and then she came over just about a month ago and Kevin did the final touches on her and he did a fabulous job."

The decision to run Munnyfor Ro, now 2-2-2 from nine starts starts with earnings of \$320,985, in the Queen's Plate, will be made in the coming days.

"A mile and a quarter is going to be her trip; I'm not worried about the distance. We'll see how she comes out of the race and then we're going to have to sit down and talk, and see if supplementing her is the next move."

The Woodbine Oaks has served as a Queen's Plate stepping-stone for fillies. Oaks-Plate champions include Holy Helena (2017), Lexie Lou (2014), Inglorious (2011), and Dancethruthedawn (2001). In 2018, Oaks runner-up Wonder Gadot went on to win the Queen's Plate.

Munnyfor Ro was bred in Ontario by Daybar and is the second foal out of the Distorted Humor mare Repartee, whose latest registered foal is a yearling Unified filly. She was purchased by Raroma Stables for \$65,000 out of the Woods Edge Farm consignment to the 2019 Keeneland September Yearling Sale.

Earlier in the day D-Mac Racing Stable and La Huerta's Avoman proved the best in a field of four Canadian-bred 3-year-olds in the CA\$150,000 (US\$120,197) Plate Trial Stakes, getting by the others to score by three-quarters of a length in the 1 1/8-mile test.

Trained by Donald MacRae, the Old Forester gelding made a bid for the lead from third while three wide on the turn. Under Antonio Gallardo, Avoman got a head in front of Truffle King as they entered the stretch. That foe ducked in at the eighth pole and was later disqualified to fourth and last. Avoman completed the distance in 1:52.84.

Avoman brought his record to two wins and two thirds in five starts with earnings of \$137,314.

Bred in Ontario by Joey Gee Thoroughbreds, he is out of the Tethra mare Cosa Rara, also the dam of stakes winners Cawaja Beach, Who's Big Daddy, and Professor's Ride. He was a US\$45,096 purchase by Jim Bruce out of the Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency consignment to the 2019 Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society (Ontario Division) Canadian-Bred Yearling Sale. BH

GREENMAN SUSPENDED 30 DAYS IN ANIMAL WELFARE CASE

Trainer Dean Greenman has been suspended 30 days by Del Mar stewards for an animal welfare issue regarding neglect, according to a stewards' ruling posted Aug. 1 by the California Horse Racing Board.

The suspension is scheduled for Aug. 9 through Sept. 7. It stems from a case addressing the horse Surfside Sunset, who was euthanized March 5 after a bout of colic, and whether Greenman followed professional veterinary advice regarding the proper care of his trainee in this situation, according to Del Mar stewards' minutes following a July 23 formal hearing with Greenman.

Sunday's ruling noted that the violation occurred March 3, 4, and 5 at Santa Anita Park.

Stewards said Greenman indicated he would appeal the suspension, the Daily Racing Form reported.

Greenman saddled a horse twice this year

according to Equibase statistics, which also shows he has trained since 1987. Both of this year's starts were made by Surfside Sunset in claiming events at Santa Anita Park, the first on Jan. 22 and the second on Feb. 12. The 7-year-old gelding finished off the board in both of those starts.

Greenman could not be reached Sunday by BloodHorse via telephone for comment. **BH**

EPIPHANEIA YEARLINGS IN HIGH DEMAND AT JBBA SALE

Epiphaneia yearlings were in great demand July 27 at the Japan Bloodhorse Breeders' Association Hokkaido Selection Sale of yearlings, at which the final figures set a sale record.

An Epiphaneia colt (Hip 154) out of Three Arrow (by Aldebaran) was secured by Masaru Shimada and topped the session at ¥60 million (US\$545,455). Another son of Epiphaneia (Hip 130) out of Smash (King Kamehameha) was purchased by Noboru Iyama for ¥54 million (\$490,909), the second-highest price of the day. Both colts have a 3x4 cross of Sunday Silence.

Five out of the top 11 yearlings sold were by Epiphaneia, a son of Symboli Kris S.

The stallion is the third foal out of 2005 American Oaks Invitational (G1T) winner Cesario, the first Japanese-trained horse to win a grade 1 in the United States. The mare also produced Japanese grade 1 winners Leontes and Saturnalia.

A favorite on the turf, Epiphaneia won the 2013 Kikuka Sho (Japanese St. Leger, G1) and the 2014 Japan Cup (G1). From his first crop, Daring Tact won the 2020 Japanese Triple Tiara. Efforia, winner

of this year's Satsuki Sho (Japanese Two Thousand Guineas, G1), is from his second crop.

A total of 202 yearlings from 240 cataloged sold at the JBBA Selection Sale for gross receipts of ¥3,650,700,000 (\$33.2 million), an 11.9% increase from 2020, with an average price of ¥18,072,772 (\$164,298), and a median price of ¥16 million (\$145,455); a steady growth of 1.9% and 6.7% respectively from 2020. The clearance rate improved from 82.5% in 2020 to 86.3% at this year's sale. BH

AWAY HE GOES LINES UP FOR MELBOURNE CUP BID

British representation is likely to be considerably smaller in this year's Lexus Melbourne Cup (G1), but one stayer primed for Australia's biggest race is Away He Goes after a career-best second in the Al Shaqab Goodwood Cup (G1).

Newmarket trainer Ismail Mohammed plans to break new ground by saddling Away He Goes, his first runner in Australia, in the Flemington showpiece and favors a trip to France for the Aug. 22 Prix Kergorlay (G2) at Deauville as a next target.

Owned by Khalifa Saeed Sulaiman, Away He Goes finished third to subsequent Gold Cup (G1) hero Subjectivist in the Dubai Gold Cup Sponsored By Al Tayer Motors (G2) in March, and stepped up on his return placing fifth in the John Smith's Silver Cup (G3) at York, and beaten 3 3/4 lengths by Trueshan at Glorious Goodwood.

The three-time winner has only once finished out of the first five in 15 starts. He finished second to Logician on debut in 2019 before beating Friday's L'Ormarins Queen's Plate Glorious Stakes (G3) winner Passion And Glory in his second start. He is versatile regarding ground, giving Mohammed hope that the Melbourne Cup is a suitable target.

"The plan is to go to Australia for the Melbourne Cup, then head back to Dubai for the winter with him," Mohammed said. "I've never had a runner in Australia so it's exciting, and I hope we're going to the right place with the right horse. He'll go straight to the big race after quarantine over there.

"He's come back from Goodwood in good shape. He ran very well and surprised us as we were very worried about the ground," he added. "I was watching the race and two furlongs out he was cruising. I thought 'Oh, come on, this our day,' but he ran a great race to finish second. He ran some good races in Dubai in the winter and is lightly raced for a 5-year-old. We've always thought he was a good horse and he has just improved with time. He's entered in the Ebor, which is an option, but he's more likely to go to Deauville that week instead."

Although Away He Goes is unlikely to be in action on the Knavesmire, Mohammed will be represented at York in the Sky Bet Lowther (G2) with recent Princess Margaret Keeneland Stakes (G3) winner Zain Claudette.

The Saeed H Al Tayer-owned filly cost £20,000 (US\$26,735) as a yearling last year and took her record to two wins in three starts in the Ascot group 3 with a nose victory over Desert Dreamer. She is a best price 7-1 with Paddy Power and Betfair Sportsbook for the Aug. 19 group 2 contest worth £150,000.

"We were contemplating going for a sales race with her but we're going to run her in the Lowther after talking with the owners," Mohammed said. "I feel she's something super; we bought her cheaply and she's quality. She has a very good turn of foot and picked up well to win at Ascot.

"We're a small yard but busy with 46 horses now and everyone is working very hard to get good results on the track, so it's very rewarding when the horses run well."

FANSHawe AT A LOSS TO EXPLAIN AUDARYA'S POOR NASSAU RUN

James Fanshawe remains at a loss to explain the disappointing run of stable star Audarya in the July 29 Qatar Nassau Stakes (G1), a race in which she managed to beat just one of her five rivals despite being sent off the 9-4 joint-favorite.

Twice a top-level winner last year when successful in the Darley Prix Jean Romanet (G1) at Deauville and the Maker's Mark Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf (G1T) at Keeneland, Audarya returned to action with a bang this season when running dual classic winner Love to three-quarters of a length in the Prince of Wales's Stakes (G1) at Royal Ascot but failed to build on that performance when finishing 7 3/4 lengths behind Lady Bowthorpe at Goodwood.

Despite running below par, Audarya has returned to Fanshawe's Pegasus Stables in Newmarket seemingly unscathed, although a close eye will be kept on the 5-year-old before her next target is selected.

"She's fine and went out for a canter this morning," said Fanshawe July 31. "It's hard to pinpoint what happened but she was fine post race and seemed nice and bright this morning. I was very disappointed. She's really consistent, which is why I'm at a bit of a loss of what to make of it really but the main thing is that she's come out of it fine and we'll pick another race out for her."

Owned by Alison Swinburn, Audarya has winning form on ground ranging from firm to soft and, despite rider William Buick suggesting the good

to soft ground at Goodwood may not have favored her, Fanshawe is inclined not to blame Thursday's conditions for her lackluster display.

"William mentioned the ground but she's won on that ground before so I can't use that as an excuse," said Fanshawe. "She just didn't fire and I don't think you can blame anything really."

The Romanet and Breeders' Cup, as well as the Prix de l'Opera Longines (G1) in which she finished a close third last year, are again among the potential targets for Audarya providing nothing sinister surfaces in the next seven days.

"We'll see if anything comes out in the wash in the next week before deciding on our next race," Fanshawe added. "Those races are definitely on the radar again but you've got to make sure she's back on song before you go for them."
